**Any Emergency 911 Crimes in progress**

**Weed & Seed** officers investigate and try to prosecute for reoccurring offenses. They serve only designated Weed & Seed Neighborhoods and generally do not answer 911 calls. Please observe details of activity and be prepared to inform W & S officers of such. Because they may be on a call at any given time, please use the following sequence of calls when you can give them some information for them to start an investigation, or in addition to 911. Weed & Seed officers will work with you on any problems.

Calling 911 or Weed & Seed to dispatch a car to the scene will usually run off suspects. If you have information about reoccurring problem activity, you should call one of the following numbers so they can check out the situation more discretely. **However, calling Weed & Seed or any number other than 911 will not count as a call for service. You must call 911 to establish a record of problems at an address.**
